

Connect to a Meeting

Along with this set of instructions you will have received a Skype for Business meeting invitation which includes a link: → [Join Skype Meeting](#)

1. Open Meeting Link. Copy the Skype meeting address from your meeting invite to your web browser.

- see [this note](#) if using Google Calendar)
- If installed, Office Communicator or a Skype for Business client may pop-up, close either of these and click the web app link.

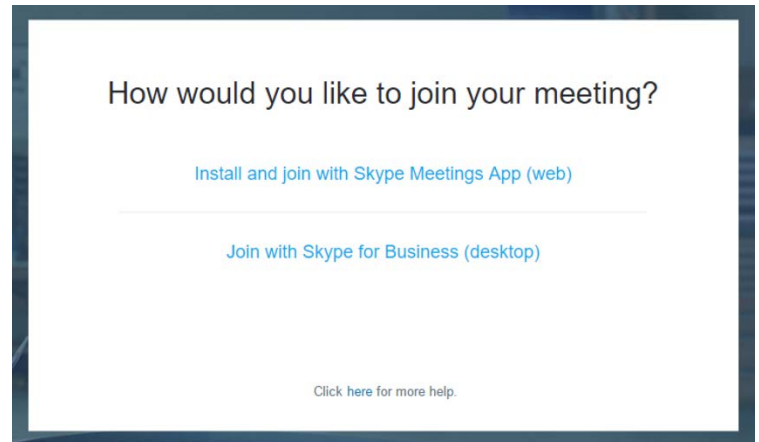


Figure 1 Skype Meetings landing page

2. Join the Meeting. (Figure 1)

- Select 'Install and join with Skype Meetings App (web)

3. Your web browser will download the Skype Meetings App, Choose to save the file if asked

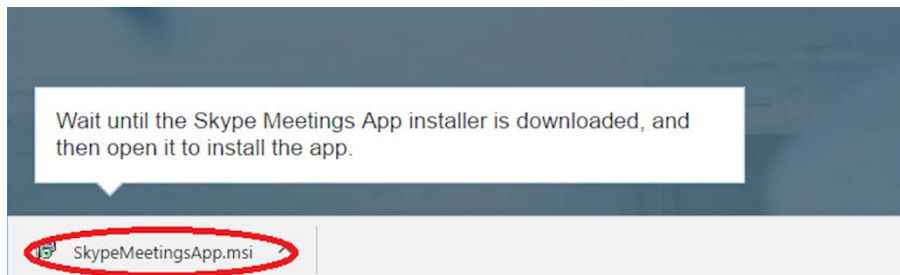


Figure 2 Skype Meetings Web-App Saving

4. Run the plugin once it has finished downloading. (Figure 2)

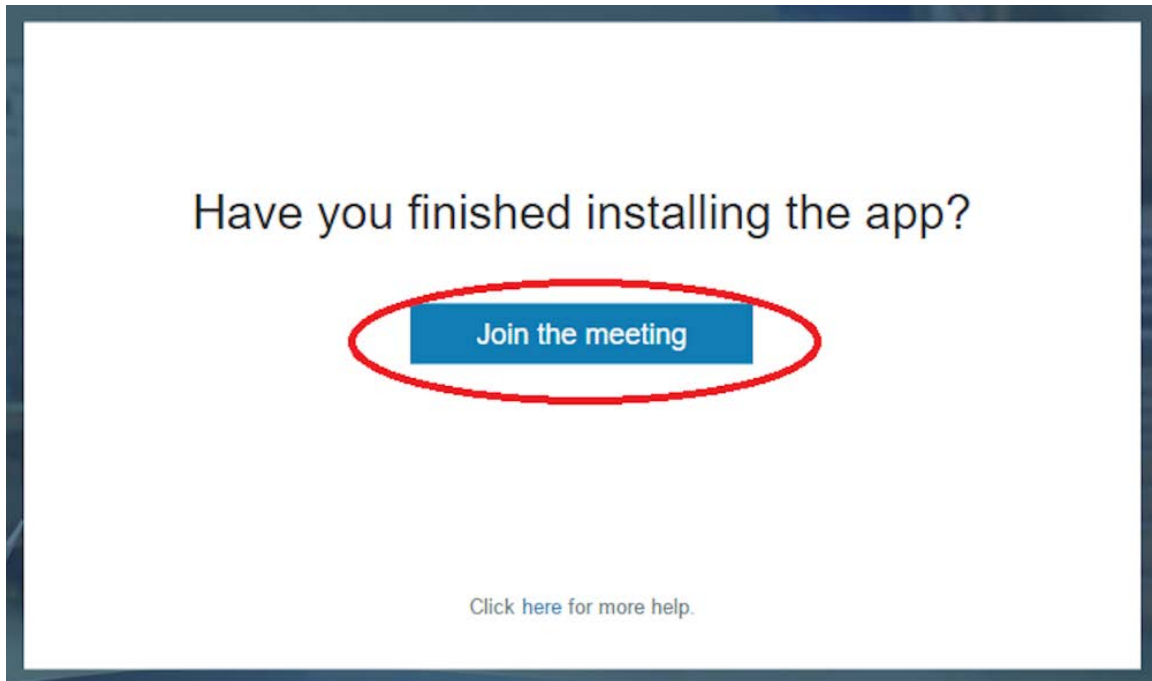


Figure 3 Join Meeting Page

5. After the installation finishes, go back to your web browser and Click 'Join the meeting'. (Figure 3)

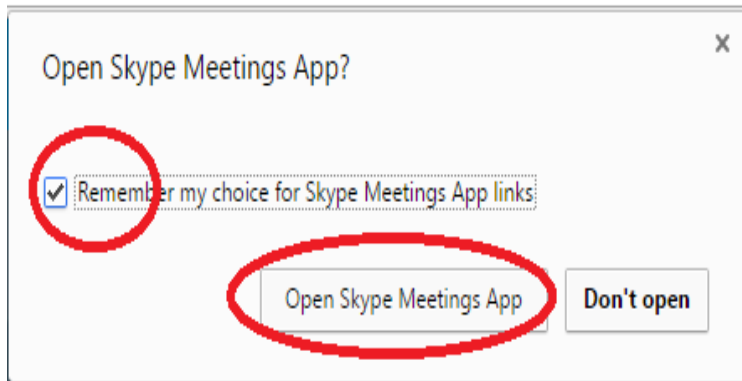


Figure 4 Chrome Skype Meetings App Launch

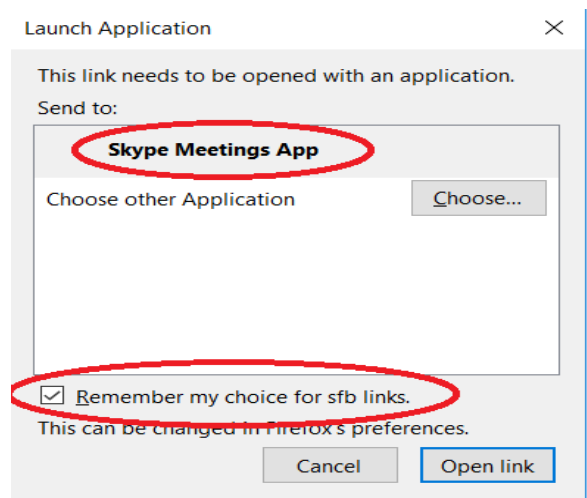


Figure 5 Firefox Skype Meetings App Launch

6. In your browser, the meeting will open a popup a prompt to launch the Skype Meetings App as shown for Chrome and for Firefox (Figures 4 & 5). Check 'Remember my choice for Skype Meetings App links' and open the meeting.

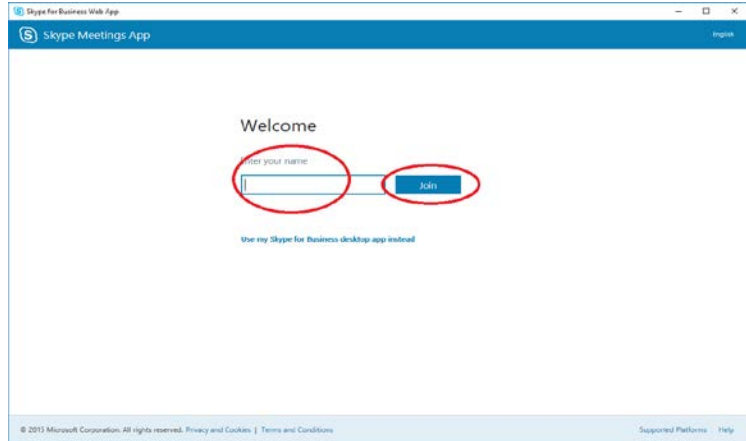


Figure 6 Enter Name and Join meeting

7. You should now be connected to the meeting in a new window of your browser. Enter your name and Click 'Join' to enter the meeting. (Figure 6)

9. The Skype Meetings App will now join you to the meeting. If you do not have a headset or microphone available, you will be prompted to connect one and rejoin the meeting.

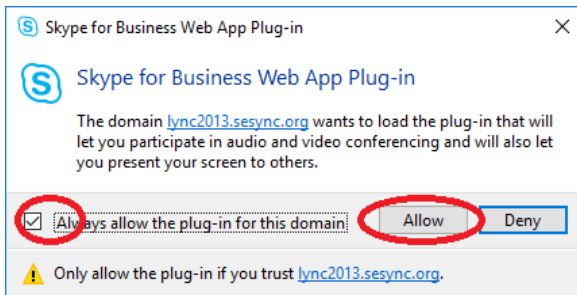


Figure 7 Edge, Firefox and Chrome Allow Skype For Business

- In Edge, Firefox and Chrome, make sure the "Always allow..." box is checked, then click "Allow" (Figure 7).

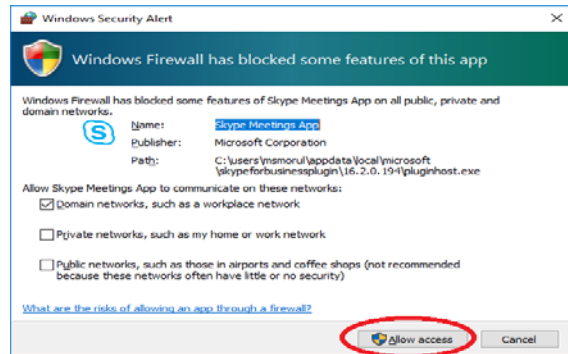
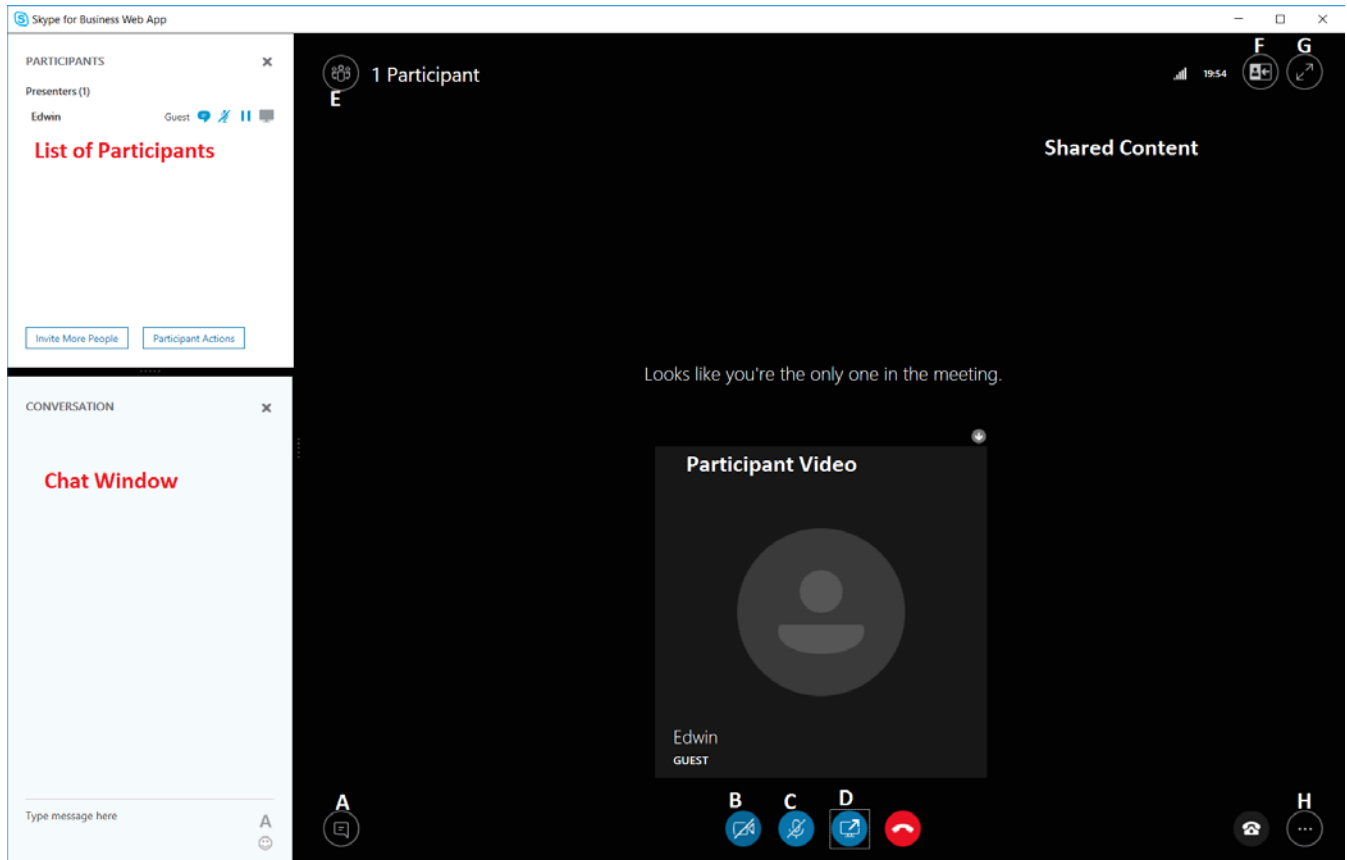


Figure 8 Edge, Firefox & Chrome Allow Network access for Skype For Business

- In Edge, Firefox and Chrome, make sure the "Domain networks..." box is checked, then click "Allow access" (Figure 8).

10. Your microphone will be muted when you join the meeting. Please be sure to un-mute and enable the camera to contribute to the discussion. (See B in figure 6 below)

Navigating your Skype Meeting

After you connect to your Skype meeting, you will see the following screen.



The meeting controls are described below.

- A. View meeting chat window
- B. Start or Stop your webcam
- C. Mute/Unmute your microphone (You will need to un-mute when you join the meeting)
- D. Share your screen or an application (See Figure 8)
- E. View meeting Attendees
- F. Change meeting layout (Only affects you)
- G. Change Meeting to Full Screen.
- H. Meeting Settings (setup your microphone, speakers, webcam)

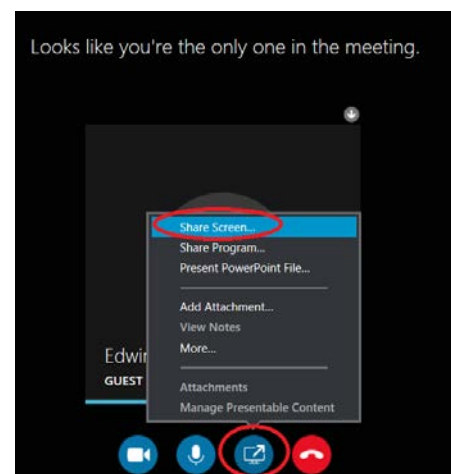


Figure 9 Sharing Content
